- **Sarbanes Oxley**

Sarbanes-Oxley (SOX), also known as the 'Public Company Accounting Reform and Investor Protection Act' and 'Corporate and Auditing Accountability and Responsibility Act,' was enacted in 2002. The bill was enacted as a reaction to a number of major corporate and accounting scandals. The legislation set new or enhanced standards for all U.S. public company boards, management and public accounting firms. A requirement of SOX calls for public organizations to keep a minimum of seven years of data, which creates enormous data storage sets and can be very challenging for most companies to manage in-house.

- **PCI-DSS**

Payment Card Industry - Data Security Standards (PCI) is defined by the PCI Security Standards Council including American Express, Discover Financial Services, JCB International, MasterCard Worldwide and Visa Inc. International, as a set of comprehensive requirements for enhancing payment account, data-security to help facilitate the broad adoption of consistent data security measures on a global basis. - **HIPAA**

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), provides federal protections for personal health information held by covered entities and gives patients an array of rights with respect to that information. At the same time, the Privacy Rule is balanced so that it permits the disclosure of personal health information needed for patient care and other important purposes. The Security Rule specifies a series of administrative, physical, and technical safeguards for covered entities to use to assure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of electronic protected health information.
